### RETURN TO ELVINGTON or HOW TO UNRETIRE AGAIN.

While out 3Swans Pring with Clive the topic of conversation went something like this "So do you fancy doing Elvington next week?" "No, I am still in retirement and I have not got a licence now", "No problem get one on the day", "I've

retired". Several miles later "Well I suppose I could". Obtaining a licence application form found me on Ward 15 at York District Hospital on the Wednesday previous, nothing serious, the Event Entries secretary was a nurse.

Friday night arrived and it was over to Clives to prepare for the day. 39YPE was sat in the workshop still sporting the Circuit of Ireland stickers, tyres and spares gathered together and loaded. The quiet rural countryside received a shock when the starter button was hit and YPE was removed from her winter hibernation.

Saturday morning I got up thinking "Why the hell did I change my mind and say yes?". When Clive arrived to pick me up he admitted the same thoughts had entered his own head.

On arrival we parked up next to Gavin with his Lada, unloaded YPE and set off for noise and scrutineering. Almost had to go to the shop in Elvington for some Brillo pads, that or borrow the item pushed up the exhaust of the Nova in front of us. However I'll say no more on the subject because we did pass. Back into the service area and Tim and John had arrived ready to change the tyres and do the things that service crew do.

MTC1 was located and a time taken, how any crew could start a rally and forget to visit MTC1 and get excluded is beyond me. No doubt someone somewhere has done just that.

SS1 started and we passed two cars on stage. We had to follow one through the water splash - **Big mistake - Huge**. I failed to slide the window fully closed on my side.

Arriving back into service, I tried to get out of the car, my legs wanted to let me down in a heap on the floor, we must have been going rather fast. A loose near side wheel bearing was discovered and rectified and we were ready for SS2. During the countdown car one Lyndon Barton's Escort Cossy came past on their second lap. Clive was away what else does a driver need to make him go quicker still! YPE was able to keep up with its more expensive relation until the going got wetter. The Hall's 16Valve Vauxhall engined Mini was parked mid stage with its bonnet up, that was one less in our class. Our time was 22 seconds faster than SS1 and fifth overall.

On SS3 we almost caught car 11 in front of us. The chicanes on the main runway had been made very tight, too tight for some. The middle one of three had almost been demolished. Not by us I must add, out times showed we had dropped to seventh overall.

On SS4 we passed car 28 on a 90 Left, when it's driver made a mess and overcooked her braking. Clive went through on the left had side on a wing and a prayer hoping our position had been noticed by the other crew and we were back up to fifth.

SS5 was very short at 2.75 miles however we remained fifth overall and fifth in class.

Next was SS6 and the stages were now reversed. With a last minute change to SB10's all round Clive's intentions for even quicker stage times were now obvious. After eating Cheese sandwiches and Cheese and Onion crisps for lunch and then being thrown around while trying to look at a map was not a good idea on my part. Without my help Clive upped the tempo to fourth overall, perhaps I should retire again.

On SS7 I put the map away and engaged Clive's auto pilot and we were faster by 16 seconds than on the previous stage holding fourth overall by 9 seconds.

SS8 at 3.4 miles was the last stage and we passed a car on the long left hand loop on the square. Then had our worst moment of the event when we failed to go into a right hand hairpin and got rather out of shape. With a large dent in the drivers door (Note. Clives side again) we crossed the stop line. We finished fourth overall and took home the first in class trophy for our day out. A great event, my most local rally ever in all my years of on and off rallying.


Thanks to Clive for letting me back in the passenger seat and thanks to Tim and John for service. A job well done.
