JASON'S AUTO CHALLENGE WINTER CHAMPIONSHIP REGULATIONS AND RESULTS.

The rules of Jason's Auto Challenges are as follows:-

Open to Selby & DMC club members only

To qualify for the overall trophy you must first be registered and registrations cannot be back dated.

The first round will be on Sunday the 18th November and will run on specified dates to be arranged later for a total of 6 rounds.

The winner will be the person who scores the most points over the six rounds.

Points scoring will be 15 for 1st, 12 for 2nd, 10 for 3rd, going down to 1 point for 12th place.

Registration will cost £5.00 for adults and £2.00 for Juniors who must be accompanied on runs by their parent at all times. Entries will cost £10 per. round for adults and £5.00 per. round for Juniors.

The Penalty for touching a cone, barrier or any obstacle will be 10 seconds.

The Penalty for crossing a specified line with one wheel only will be 15 seconds.

The Penalty for not crossing a specified line will be a Washout.

The Penalty for Short cutting, or missing a section will be a Washout.

Cars must finish with at least two wheels over the finish line but not out of the box otherwise they will receive a Washout.

Competitors may start any time after the timekeeper signals you to do so.

Jason's decision is final.
